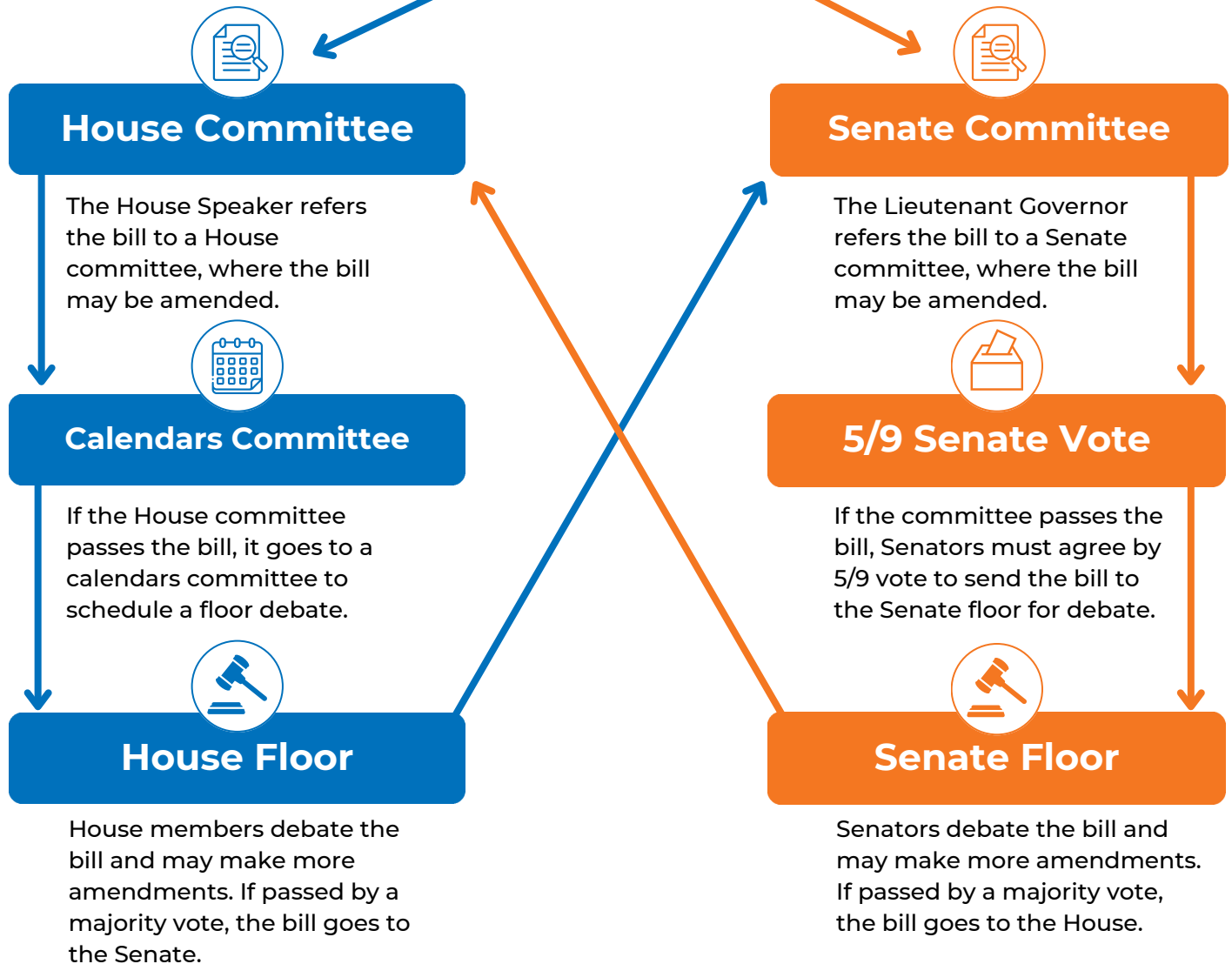


# How a Bill Becomes a Law in Texas

First, a bill is introduced in either the:

**House** or **Senate**



**All bills must pass both the House and Senate before they can be sent to the Texas Governor.**

After the House and Senate agree on the bill's language and both sides pass the bill, the Governor may:

- sign the bill into law;
- allow the bill to become law without signing; or
- veto the bill (A veto can be overridden if the bill received a 2/3 vote in the House and Senate).
